## BEGINNERS ABSEILING COURSE (Artificial)

Units covered:

**SISOABA302A** Apply single pitch abseiling on artificial surfaces

**SISOABN202A** Safeguard an abseiler using a single rope belay system

The best way to start as a novice is on this 3-day course. Personal skills, equipment understanding, knot requirements, belaying and safety covered. Unit assessments can take place if you feel you already have these skills - through confirmation only.



## ESTABLISH ROPES & GUIDING (Artificial)

Units covered:

**SISOABA303A** Establish ropes for abseiling on artificial surfaces

**SISOABA304A** Guide abseiling on single pitch artificial surfaces

During this course, a foundation of rigging skills will be shown and practised. From rigging multiple abseils to belay rigging and choices, this course will show it all. Guiding group requirements will be discussed and practised. Unit assessment from the Beginners Abseiling course will be conducted. Group assessment will need to be arranged. PD/refresher is available through confirmation only.

### VERTICAL RESCUE PD

Unit covered:

**SISOVTR301A** Perform vertical rescues

This unit covers the skills and knowledge required to use single rope techniques and mechanical advantage systems to perform self-rescues and the rescue of others. Vital skills that cover both artificial and natural surfaces along with different exercises on towers, walls and high ropes. We recommend PD annually on this unit. Assessment can take place with confirmation only.



### ABSEILING COURSES (Natural)

Training takes place around the Perth area. You will be surprised how many skills can transfer over. A good follow on from artificial skills or can be delivered with little natural experience.

Units covered:

**SISOABN202A** Safeguard an abseiler using a single rope belay system

**SISOABN303A** Apply single pitch abseiling skills on natural surfaces

**SISOABN304A** Establish ropes for single pitch abseiling on natural surfaces

**SISOABN305A** Guide abseiling on single pitch natural surfaces



### BEGINNERS CLIMBING COURSE (Artificial)

Units covered:

**SISOCLA302A** Apply top rope climbing skills on artificial surfaces

**SISOCLA303A** Establish belays for climbing on artificial surfaces

Covering all the required personal skills, equipment understanding, knot requirements, belaying and safety covered, along with climbing techniques and features. Unit assessments can take place if you feel you already have these skills - through confirmation only.

### CLIMBING GUIDE SKILLS (Artificial)

Units covered:

**SISOCLA311** Guide top rope climbing activities on artificial surfaces

\*Rescue needs are built into this unit – The Vertical Rescue unit is highly recommended and will supersede this requirement.

Guiding group requirements and rescues will be discussed and practised. Unit assessment from the Beginners Abseiling course will be conducted. Group assessment will need to be arranged. PD/refresher is available through confirmation only.



### VERTICAL RESCUE ADVANCED

This training applies to those working as outdoor guides in a range of uncontrolled activity-specific contexts in the fields of roping. Complex single and multi-pitch vertical rescues are practised during this course covering activities such as abseiling, caving and climbing activities. Vertical Rescue unit needs to be held, evidence of industry currency through a logbook needs to be shown before commencing this course.

#### Friends of Adventure Pathway

12+ months, traineeships placements in Cert III Outdoor Recreation, with Fairbridge being the RTO through your workplace (anytime start up). Contact us for further information.
